This year marks the 2nd Canadian National Steel Bridge Competition co-organized by the Canadian Society for Civil Engineers and the Canadian Institute of Steel Construction. It is modeled after the National student steel bridge competition co-organized by the American Institute of Steel Construction and the American Society of Civil Engineers. The teams design a steel bridge by themselves and then build it in a timed competition.

This year's event took place at Laval University in Quebec, Quebec. 8 teams from across the country competed on the Laval University campus.

The CSCE Capstone Competition began in 2013 as a way for senior undergraduate students to showcase their final year, or capstone, project. Each civil engineering program in Canada is able to send one team to represent their school based on their project report. Selected teams are required to distill their project to a poster board and a two minute presentation to be evaluated by industry judges
