- A completed, signed Official Submission Form
- The CV of the submitter and/or the profile of a group of individuals practicing civil engineering in Canada, or Canadian engineering firm, or a Canadian research organization
- This Project Entry Form
- The Project file: Only one copy is required. It should include the following:
 - **Project Summary** The title of the Innovation and a summary of the project (60 Words Max)
 - Project Highlights 2 Pages Maximum.
 - a) A clear description of the innovation
 - b) A comparison with the existing/conventional practice
 - c) The anticipated advantages to be obtained by the innovation
 - d) The circumstances about which the innovation was conceived
 - e) Other information you consider pertinent for consideration
 - Full Project Description. Gives full details, drawings etc. on the project. Letters of satisfaction from clients are welcome. Number of pages is not limited, but 10 pages is the recommended maximum.
 - **Photographs** A maximum of 5 photographs of the innovation will be accepted. Photographs will not be returned. Applicants must obtain the rights from their photographer to reprint the photographs without limitations.
